Our young library guests and their families need more space to learn, grow and experience the wonder of the Library.



The Library's leadership team is working with local architectural firm, Weddle Gilmore to design an

awesome and inspiring environment for youth programming with construction anticipated to begin in June of 2020.

Phase one of the expansion is funded. The unfunded dream is to have an outdoor, phase two, terrarium adjacent to the expanded space so that library users can enjoy the beautiful outdoor weather as part of their library experience.
